Cookies & Similar Technologies

Battleground Zero uses cookies and/or similar technologies on the Properties (collectively referred to as "Cookies"). A "Cookie" is a small bit of record-keeping information that many websites and other online products and services often store on a user's computer or device in order to identify it and associate activity with it. Cookies make the interaction between you and the website faster and easier by letting you navigate between pages efficiently, storing your preferences, and generally improving your experience of a website. When visiting the Properties you may have options to enable or disallow Cookies.
